

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Article 18-A of the New York State General Municipal Law will be held by the County of Monroe Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on Thursday, the 12th day of November, 2020 at 10:00 a.m., local time, at the Greece Town Hall, One Vince Tofany Boulevard, Greece, New York 14612. **PLEASE NOTE** the special hearing logistics and instructions included at the end of this notice.

SOUTH PARK DEVELOPMENT, LLC, a New York limited liability company for itself, or a related entity formed or to be formed (collectively, the "Company") has requested that the Agency assist with a certain Project (the "Project"), consisting of: (A) the acquisition of a leasehold interest in a portion of the vacant approximately 73±-acre parcel of land located at 1200 Lexington Avenue in the Town of Greece, New York (the "Land"); (B) the construction on the Land of a one-story approximately 180,000 square-foot building (collectively, the "Improvements"); and (C) the acquisition and installation therein, thereon or thereabout of certain machinery, equipment and related personal property (the "Equipment" and, together with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility"); for use as a distribution facility. The Facility will be initially operated and/or managed by the Company.

The Agency will acquire a leasehold interest in the Facility and lease the Facility back to the Company. At the end of the lease term the Agency's leasehold interest will be terminated. The Agency contemplates that it will provide financial assistance (the "Financial Assistance") to the Company in the form of sales and use tax exemptions, a mortgage recording tax exemption, consistent with the policies of the Agency, and a partial real property tax abatement.

SPECIAL PUBLIC HEARING CONDUCT INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION:

In accordance with Section 859-a of the Act, a representative of the Agency will be at the above-stated time and place to present a copy of the Company's project Application (including a cost-benefit analysis), which is also available for viewing on the Agency's website at: <https://monroecountyida.org/incentives-and-programs/projects/>. Given the COVID-19 public health crisis and related Executive Orders issued by Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, the Agency will also accommodate virtual public attendance and participation at this hearing. Interested parties will be provided a reasonable opportunity, both orally and in writing, to present their views with respect to the Project, either in-person at the hearing or virtually by visiting the Agency's livestream of the Public Hearing live on its YouTube channel at https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCfd3PpBrm5ZRh5z2_lqeJ5Q/featured, with written comments accepted on that platform in real time. In addition, the Agency will provide public access to the hearing via conference bridge at 1-866-804-5312, passcode 5854198769. Finally, interested parties may submit written comments to the Agency, which will all be included within the public hearing record.
